Items, which are not permitted as part of our dress code:

Nut Free School

We are a nut free school. Nuts and products containing nuts including Nutella and other equivalent spreads should not be brought into school at any time.



Water Bottles

We encourage all pupils to bring a filled water bottle to school each day. It is best if this is a refillable bottle with a straw.

Please do not send your child to school with a Stanley cup or similar style cup. These are large, heavy and take up a lot of space on desks. They are ceramic and can smash when dropped. They are also impractical for school and get in the way of learning. They are not safe to take to the playground. Thanks for your co-operation.

Snack

We encourage you to send your child to school with a small healthy snack. Break is only 15 minutes and pupils often don't have a chance to run around with friends if they have multiple snacks to eat. We would encourage a piece of fruit such as an apple or banana and a drink.

Playground

A reminder that adults are not allowed in the playground at any time. This is to ensure the safeguarding of all pupils.

New P1 Parents – Message from Mr Lumsden

I wanted to express our gratitude for your support and cooperation this week. Without exception, our new Primary 1 children have settled in very well and appear to have enjoyed their first few days of primary school. We very much look forward to welcoming them back for their first full week on Monday. I have included some information below, which I hope you find useful.

Our Breakfast Club runs from 8:30 each morning and can be accessed as required without pre-booking. If you want to make use of this service, please bring your child to the main entrance between 8:30 and 8:50 and they will be directed into the hall. Breakfast Club is currently free for all pupils from Primary 1-5.

For children not wishing to attend Breakfast Club, the infant gate/door will be opened and staffed from 8:45. Primary 1 children should not be dropped off in the infant area before this time as they will be unsupervised.

From Monday all children will be dismissed at 15:00. Primary 1 children must be picked up by an adult from the infant area just inside the infant gate. Children will remain with a member of staff until they are able to identify the adult picking them up.

P.E. days - Room 1 are Tuesday (indoor) and Friday (outdoor).

Room 2 are Tuesday (indoor) and Wednesday (outdoor).

If you require any further information, please speak to a member of school staff.

Reminder - Safe Parking

Please do not park on the zigzags.

The Staff Car Park should not be used by parents collecting pupils.

Please park safely on Footfield Rd and allow your child to walk safely on the footpath to the

gate.

We all need to work together in order to prevent an accident from happening.

It is an offence to park/stop/drop off on the zigzags.
