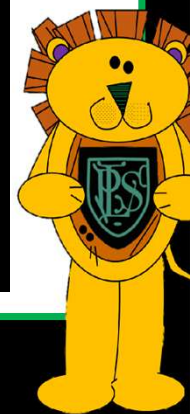

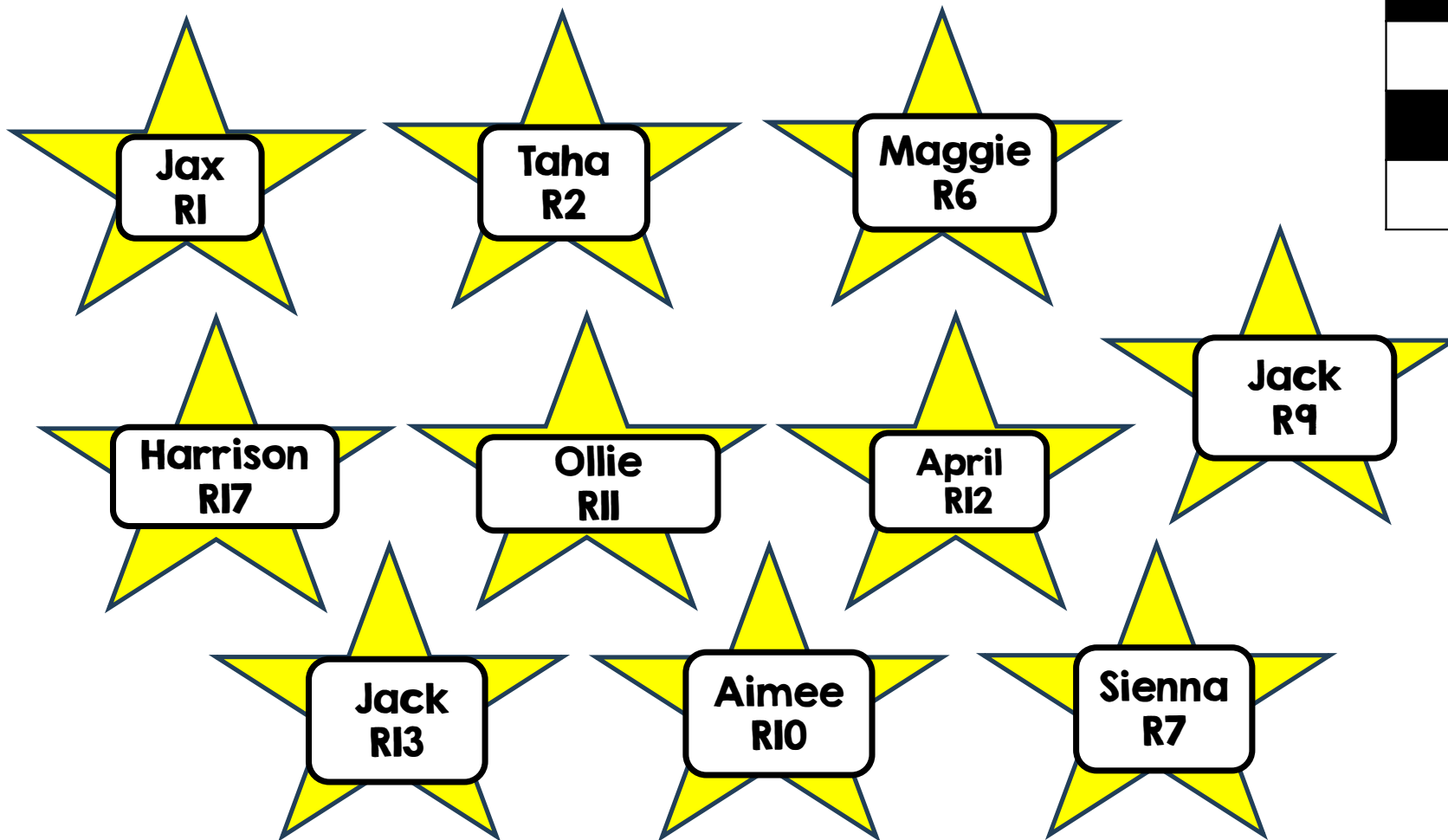

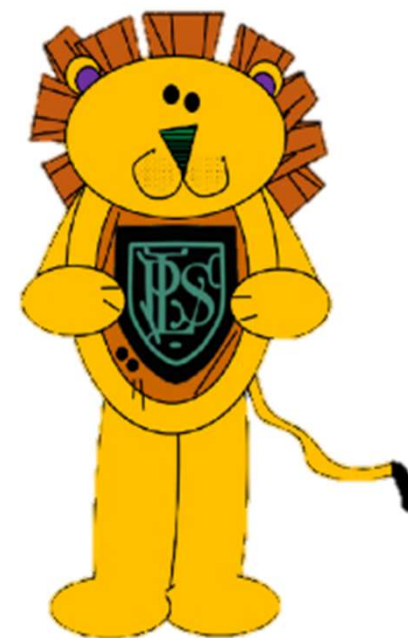

## Toys in School

## Homework/Good to be Green

Homework remains optional for all families. We would always encourage extra practice at home but appreciate it may be difficult for some families for a variety of reasons.

We do need to work together when it comes to pupil behaviour in school and ask that adults look weekly for their child's good to be green record and signs/comments. We encourage all pupils to look after their record sheet and diary and be a responsible citizen by returning it to the class daily. Thanks

## Nut Free School

We are a nut free school. Nuts and products containing nuts including Nutella and other equivalent spreads should not be brought into school at any time.



## Changes to Pick Up

Please try to advise your child where they should go or who is picking them up in the morning before school. Should this change please let us know as soon as possible and preferably before lunchtime. Please keep phone calls to the office after this time to a minimum and only in an emergency situation where you will be held up etc. Sometimes we only have one member of staff in the office and it is very difficult to get multiple messages to multiple pupils at the last minute. ## Snack

We encourage you to send your child to school with a small healthy snack. Break is only 15 minutes and pupils often don't have a chance to run around with friends if they have multiple snacks to eat. We would encourage a piece of fruit such as an apple or banana and a drink.
