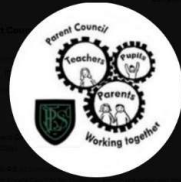
Christmas Jumpers

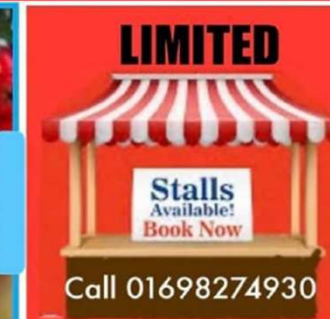
