



#### Validated Self-Evaluation Inspection

As part of the ongoing support from North Lanarkshire Council, the school will take part in a Validated Self-Evaluation (VSE) visit on Tuesday 7th March and Wednesday 8th March 2023.

A VSE is an internal review of the school's current progress in Learning, Teaching and Assessment, and Raising Attainment and Achievement. This will help us to identify our strengths and any potential areas for development.

During the two days, they will visit classes to observe lessons, look at the work of the pupils, engage in professional dialogue with the staff and meet with representative groups of parents and pupils.

Feedback from the VSE will be shared with staff towards the end of the week and this will be used to inform our school improvement work going forward. These areas are for the school bus and staff and should not be used by any other vehicles. Thank you for your support in this matter.

#### NUT ALLERGIES

Due to the number of children with nut allergies, we ask that you do not give your child snacks/lunches that contain nuts or traces of nuts. We also ask that pupils are given appropriate healthy snacks. A reminder that no chewing gum is allowed in school.

#### WATER BOTTLES

In order to encourage good hydration, it is important that children have access to water at all times. Please provide your child with a filled plastic bottle (or 2) of water, with their name on it. It would be useful if it had a sports top to prevent spills. Children should not be bringing energy drinks or fizzy drinks to school, with the drinking of plain water encouraged.

#### SCHOOL TRANSPORT

If your child is eligible for school transportation, an application form must be approved by NLC Transport Section. This can be emailed to them. Please contact the school when your child's application has been approved.

If your child has access to the bus, please remind them they must remain in their seats, with their seat belt on.

If there is a family of 2 or 3 children in P6 and P7, breakfast costs £1.50 for 2 children and £1.80 for three children.
