We continue to appeal for your support with;

- Parents and carers 'dropping off' and 'picking up' their children beyond the perimeter fence on Liberty Rd or the new back gate
- ALL authorised visitors to follow the guidance from staff
- Pupils are accessing their Zones via any of the open gates; **RED ZONE** Early Years / P1-3 P4 -7 YELLOW ZONE **GREEN ZONE**
 - **Construction area NO ENTRY TO SCHOOL**
- Pupils arriving in their zones as near to the 9am start BELL as possible
- Pupils are supervised in all playgrounds by staff and SMT from 8.50am
- Breakfast Club children walk to the main entrance door of the school for 8.20 am on their own as Breakfast Club staff are waiting at the main door of the school.
- PLEASE DO NOT ACCESS THE SCHOOL CARPARK, this is unsafe for pupils. We don't want another 'near miss' as there is a SAFE **PUPIL WALKWAY from LIBERTY RD to the school door**
- OUTDOOR LEARNING and PE are still accessed by Staff for their class (weather permitting).
- Please be aware of your child's PE day so that they are ready for the activities ie Polo top already on, shorts under skirts / trousers for a quick change. (no football colours at any time) Gym shoes to change into from outdoor shoes.


