Dear Parents / Carers and friends,

Any aspects that need more effort will be worked on in their new class in 2024 / 2025.

Our 'Digital Learning Journals' have been a great success for parents and carers to 'tune in to' to view their pupils in action and show how focused their learning has been and the successes they have in readiness for next year. - Pupils arriving in their zones at 8.50am—9am start BELL as possible
- Pupils are supervised in all playgrounds by staff and SMT from 8.50am
- Breakfast Club children walk to the main entrance door of the school for 8.20 am on their own.
 Breakfast Club staff are waiting at the main door of the school every day.
- PLEASE DO NOT ACCESS THE SCHOOL CARPARK, this is unsafe for pupils to enter at any time.

- OUTDOOR LEARNING and PE are still accessed by Staff for their class (weather permitting).
- Please be aware of your child's PE day so that they are ready for the activities ie Polo shirt already on, shorts under skirts / trousers for a quick change. (no football colours) Gym shoes to change into from outdoor shoes.

URGENT ACTION FOR EXCELLENT ATTENDANCE

Your child's ATTENDANCE matters. NLC's target for attendance is 95% or more. This is then an achievement of excellent attendance and consistent days where your child is NOT missing out on Learning and Teaching and can remember from day to day what they have learned. From this daily start, your child will not be worried about lessons missed and will be able to build confidence in what they can achieve and learn, every day.

CNHS Cluster have agreed that improvement for attendance is incredibly important. Sacred Heart Pr, St Gerard's Pr, Holy Family Pr, St JPII Primary and of course Cardinal Newman High School will form an attendance panel to monitor closely unauthorised absences, holidays taken through the school terms and unexplained absences not reported and that keeps our pupils in their school.

This MUST stop, to help support our pupils through their Educational career, where they achieve academically and feel confident that by excellent attendance and guidance from home, they can build on their skills to fulfil all the tasks teachers diligently and daily plan for them. Every school in our Cluster will work collectively to **MONITOR** and stamp out frequent absences and **unauthorised holidays** taken in school learning time. We will continue to monitor your child's progress in this as you will see reported in the Summer Report.


