

**Remember use your number square to help you.**

Last week we worked on some addition sums, this week we will work on subtraction. Subtraction means to take away, which means the answer will always be less than the total number.

**Example:  $10 - 8 = 2$**

Look at the answer, it is less than the total number at the start of the number sentence. We would start at the number 10 on our number square and **go back** 8 place. We are subtraction 8 from a total of 10.
