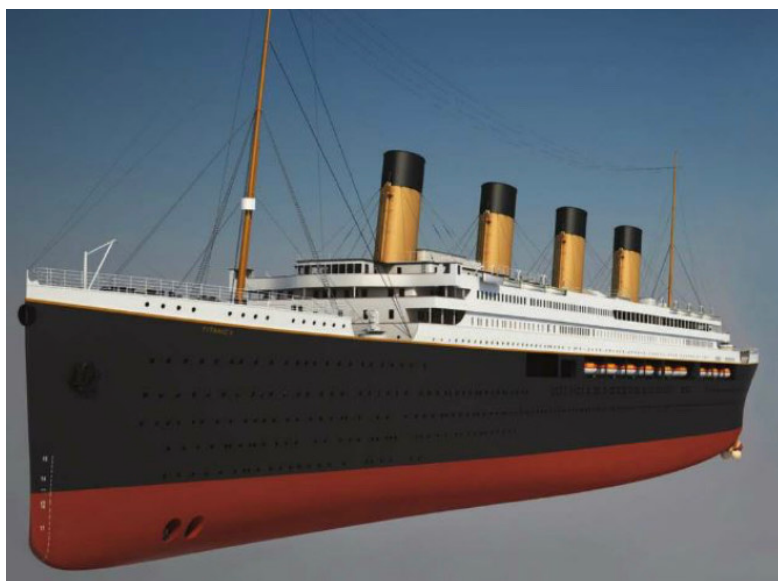
This week we're going to look at the construction of the Titanic. The Titanic was the biggest and most luxurious passenger ship of its time. Construction began on March 31, 1909.
