

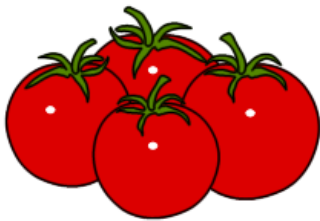
Money Word Problems

5. I have just been shopping. I bought my sister a bag which cost £8.10 and my brother a watch which cost £9.49. How much did I spend on presents?



6. I have £10.00 to spend on my lunch. My lunch costs 4.35. How much money do I have left?
