

## Sherlock Holmes Blue Ch3&4

This week I would like you to read up to the end of chapter 4 and complete the tasks below.

### Comprehension

1. What information does the author give us about Mr McCarthy on Page 13?
2. Why is it difficult for Holmes to investigate the tracks? P14
3. What evidence does Holmes have to suggest the stone was the murder weapon? P14 and 15
4. What evidence does Holmes have about the height? P18
5. What impression do you get of Mr Turner on P18 and 19?

### Inference

The author gives us many descriptions that infer clues about the characters. Here is an example:

“His face was white and his lips tinged with blue.” P18

The colour of his face implies he is very unwell as paleness is often associated with illness. The fact that his lips are also blue implies he is cold, has a fever perhaps or is suffering from an illness.

Find 5 more quotes from ch4 and 5 and explain what they imply about a character or about any evidence that Holmes discovers!
