### Task 1

In chapter 1, you are given lots of information about Trudy and find out that she can be referred to as trouble. I would like you to do a character profile for Trudy, writing what you have found out about her so far. Draw a picture of Trudy and write her name above it, and then write words and sentences around the picture to describe her. You can write information about what she looks like, her personality, what she likes and what happens around her. Here is a picture of her below that you can use.



## Task 2

In chapters 1 and 2, you find out that Trudy is very clumsy and get into trouble. She has a habit of knocking things over, tripping up, bumping into things and much more. I would like you to write a summary of chapters 1 and 2, identifying the different things that Trudy did. Remember to choose the main parts of the story to write about, that are the most important and most interesting.

8. Do you think it was a good idea that Trudy went into Mrs Willow's house? (Page 22)
9. What do you think will happen when Trudy is in Mrs Willow's house?
