### Task 1

In chapters 3 and 4, Mrs Willow told Trudy that she used to be clumsy and felt like an ugly duckling. But Mrs Willow then said that she grew up to be a swan and Trudy would do the same. Trudy then told herself she was a swan and she tried to be less clumsy. I would like you to write a summary of these two chapters, writing the main points about what happened. Remember to read the chapters, think about the most important things that happened in them and then write them in your summary. Try to use your own words instead of taking sentences straight from the book.

### Task 2

#### Chapters 3 and 4 Comprehension

Read the questions below and look for the answers in the book. Remember to answer every question in a full sentence.

1. What was the most beautiful thing in Mrs Willow's house?  
(Page 23)
2. What was the disaster that happened? (Pages 27-29)
3. Why did Trudy not think Mrs Willow could be clumsy? (Page 32)
4. What happened when Trudy went to school on the bus? (Pages 38-39)
