



### What is Parents Portal?

Parents Portal is a digital service to help replace the traditional school bag run by providing direct communication to parents and carers through a selection of online services.

### Who can use it?

Access to Parents Portal is only for those parents or carers who have children in Primary 1 through to the final year of secondary and are already confirmed as a contact for that child.

If your child(ren) is about to start at a North Lanarkshire school or your child(ren) will be starting in P1 or S1 from August, your school will inform you during their first term when you can set up your account.

### What will you see?

 Absences	 Annual Data Check
 Attendance	 Class Timetable
 Notice Board	 Permission Slips
 Report Cards	 Young Persons' Free Bus Travel

### How do you sign up?

Access to [parentsportal.scot](https://parentsportal.scot) is through [myaccount](https://myaccount.scot), a service which allows you to access a range of Scottish public services online using one username and password. It also makes it a one-stop-shop for digital services available in North Lanarkshire.

Once you have registered for a myaccount, and agreed to the conditions, you will be able to use the same login details to sign into [parentsportal.scot](https://parentsportal.scot).
