#### FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

P4 will be making the Sacrament of First Holy Communion on Sunday 19th of May 2024 in St. Monica's Church. The service will start at 12pm. There will be a photographer available 1 hour before Mass. Please refrain from taking photographs during the service. If you choose not to have a photo, the children should be seated in the Church no later than 10 minutes before Mass begins.



The front rows are reserved for the children making their First Holy Communion. Parent/Carers of those children will sit opposite where 2 spaces will be allocated. Other family members are more than welcome to sit behind these rows or the spaces in the wings of the church. Staff members will also have a row allocated.
