## P1 Induction

The induction day for all children who will be attending Westfield Primary School in August 2019 will be held on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> May at 10am. The Induction Day should be attended by both parents and children. Morning session children can drop their children at nursery as normal. Parents will be meeting with the Head Teacher in the hall so should use the main entrance. Afternoon session parents should bring their children with them and access the building using the main school entrance.

The children will have the opportunity to meet their class teacher and their upper school buddy. They will take part in some activities in the classroom and will use the playground (weather dependent). Lunches will be offered at the end of the induction day.

Pre-school children are invited to attend a Teddy bears picnic on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> June at 1pm and the Beach Party Disco on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> June at 6:30pm. A responsible adult must remain with your child for the duration of the disco.

## Sunny Weather

With the warmer weather approaching (fingers crossed) we would ask that all children come to nursery suitably clothed. Please ensure that your child's name is written on all of their labels to make it easy for staff to identify their belongings. We would also ask that you apply sun cream to any areas of their skin which could be exposed to the sun during the nursery session. If you do not yet have your sun cream the nursery provides Nivea Factor 50 in the cloakroom area. Please also ensure that the children are wearing appropriate footwear. Sandals and flip flops can be a hazard due to the increased risk of tripping and the potential for items to be dropped on their exposed toes.

## Exploring the local area

Throughout this topic we may take the children on short walks to explore the environment and find new life. We plan to walk to St Maurice's pond on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> April and will need some parent helpers to accompany the children. There is a parent sign up sheet in the nursery cloakroom if you are able to come along.
