Transition from nursery to primary

We have an established programme at Westfield to ensure a smooth transition for all children when moving from nursery to primary:



* August to October the new Primary 1 children visit the nursery once per week to spend time with their friends and staff.

* October to Christmas the pre-school children work with the Primary 1 children in the open area in a free play context, for an hour per week.

* Christmas to summer the pre-school children work with the Primary 1 teachers and children in the open area and the classrooms, completing structured play activities.

* Wednesday 12th June, 1pm: Teddy Bears Picnic

* Thursday 13th June, 6:30pm: Beach Party Disco
