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Poverty Proofing Group - Diane and Lynn are keen to implement and improve our poverty proofing policy to ensure equality and remove barriers to learning at our school. Last year we set up our Uniform Swap Shop which has not had a great response so we will be thinking of different and new ways to improve this and help parents meet the financial demands of school life. Traffic Safety Group - You have told us you are concerned about the traffic safety and parking around the school, so we have set up a traffic safety group led by Victoria and Debbie. We will be looking for some parent volunteers with a vested interest in creating safer school drop offs and pickups. In the meantime, can we please ask parent to be mindful of where they park (not on the main road or in the bus stops) and to keep speed below 20mph.

General update from our last meeting:

- Toilets- After many emails to NLC and help from parents, NLC have confirmed our school toilets will be refurbished woooohoooo!! Date to be confirmed.........
- Lack of communication the school has had a difficult start to the year with various IT issues with email addresses, Twitter and Glow. All of these issues are slowly resolving themselves and communication should improve over the coming weeks. If parents have any concerns, they are most welcome to contact the office. Mrs Ellington has confirmed that despite the teething problems with IT the children are very happy and settled in school. She understands the frustrations parents have had but also asks for patience as there is still a significant amount of admin and restrictions associated with the current pandemic. Post meeting note: Mrs Ellington has issued further updates to answer parents' questions.
- Water children should bring water to school. If they run out the school office can refill as only the staff kitchen has drinkable water. Normal water fountains are not in use due to covid transmission risk.
- Traffic NLC have been contacted by the PC regarding the crossing point issues. Traffic
 safety group has been set up. Post meeting note: we contacted the council and they
 have advised they cannot fill the crossing point vacancy the Janitor will fill the role in
 the meantime.
- Homework help please contact your child's teacher if you require any further help or guidance with your Childs homework.
- Mindfulness Mrs Ellington will explore the use of mindfulness in the classroom again.
