Welcome

What an amazing term so far and our children have been very busy settling back into nursery life and making new friends at nursery. We have been focusing on following the rules and routines within our nursery and the children are making great progress with this.

This month our curricular focus will be Autumn/Halloween focus. The children will be given the opportunity to participate in a variety of themed learning opportunities and we welcome your feedback on these. During October your children will be exploring Halloween, as we become aware of celebrations in religious people's lives. We will explore a variety of materials to help us record our ideas and feelings. We will also be exploring numbers in and around our environment to help us to count from 0-20. Our health and wellbeing focus this month is healthy and the children will be encouraged to demonstrate different ways of being active. We would ask that you continue to support your child's learning at home by practising our song/rhyme of the month and Makaton sign at home with your child. The children are always eager to share what they have learned at home and in nursery.

However if you would like to discuss your child's progress at any point please feel free to discuss this with your child's key worker at an agreed time.
