



What Are We Learning About

The children are learning about being active and the impact that this has on their body. We are learning how to explore different ways of moving our body rhythmically through discussions about our achievements from extra-curricular groups including dancing, gymnastics, and football. We will be participating in dancing, singing, talent shows and engaging with active experiences. We would love you to share any photographs of your child being active at any of their extra-curricular clubs or at home so that we can share and develop our achievements wall. The photographs will also help us to share real life examples and develop our language when describing the positions and directions as we create dances and engage with yoga and other activities. We will be exploring how to write and mark make as we learn how to hold a pencil and explore a variety of letters and sounds.
