When entering the nursery cloakroom, we would ask that you assist your child in hanging up their coat and bag on their designated peg. We would then ask that parents/carers direct their children to our nursery toilet to wash their hands prior to entering the nursery playrooms, and then on to their designated room for their group. Please alert your child's keyworker when handing over your child and ensure that you sign the sign in sheet to confirm their attendance. The rooms for the groups are as follows.

Room 2 - Blue Group — Mrs McCammon

Purple Group - Ms Parszewska

Yellow Group – Mrs Grant

This term our initial learning focus will be settling our returning children and our new starts. We cannot wait to meet you all! Please keep an eye on our learning wall to keep up to date with some of the exciting things we have planned for the children this term. We will also be continuing with our Rhyme, Story and Makaton sign of the moment which will also be shared with you to allow you the opportunity to practise these at home with your child. If there is an occasion where your child is collected by another adult such as a childminder, then this form will be placed in your child's bag to be signed and returned to us promptly.

Our children are given the opportunity for free flow play both indoors and outdoors. We would ask that you ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for all weather conditions when attending nursery and that spare clothes are provided should your child require to be changed throughout the session. We would also ask that you apply appropriate sun protection to your child prior to bringing them to nursery, thank you!
