Welcome

What an amazing term so far and our children have been very busy settling back into nursery life and making new friends at nursery. We have been focusing on following the rules and routines within our nursery and the children are making great progress with this.

This month our curricular focus will be Autumn/Halloween focus. The children will be given the opportunity to participate in a variety of themed learning opportunities and we welcome your feedback on these. During October your children will be exploring Halloween, as we become aware of celebrations in religious people's lives. We will be exploring measure in a variety of ways and new vocabulary liked with this. Throughout this month our health and wellbeing focus will be on how to move our bodies in a variety of ways and share space with others. We will be focusing on promoting healthy lifestyles and the children and parents/carers will be given the opportunity to participate in a variety of activities together so please keep an eye on our noticeboard for further information.

We will be exploring patterns of sound through rhyme through revisiting familiar rhymes and learning new songs and rhymes. We would ask that you continue to support your child's learning at home by practising our song/rhyme of the month and Makaton sign at home with your child.

Personal Learning Plans and Focus Child

However if you would like to discuss your child's progress at any point please feel free to discuss this with your child's key worker at an agreed time.
