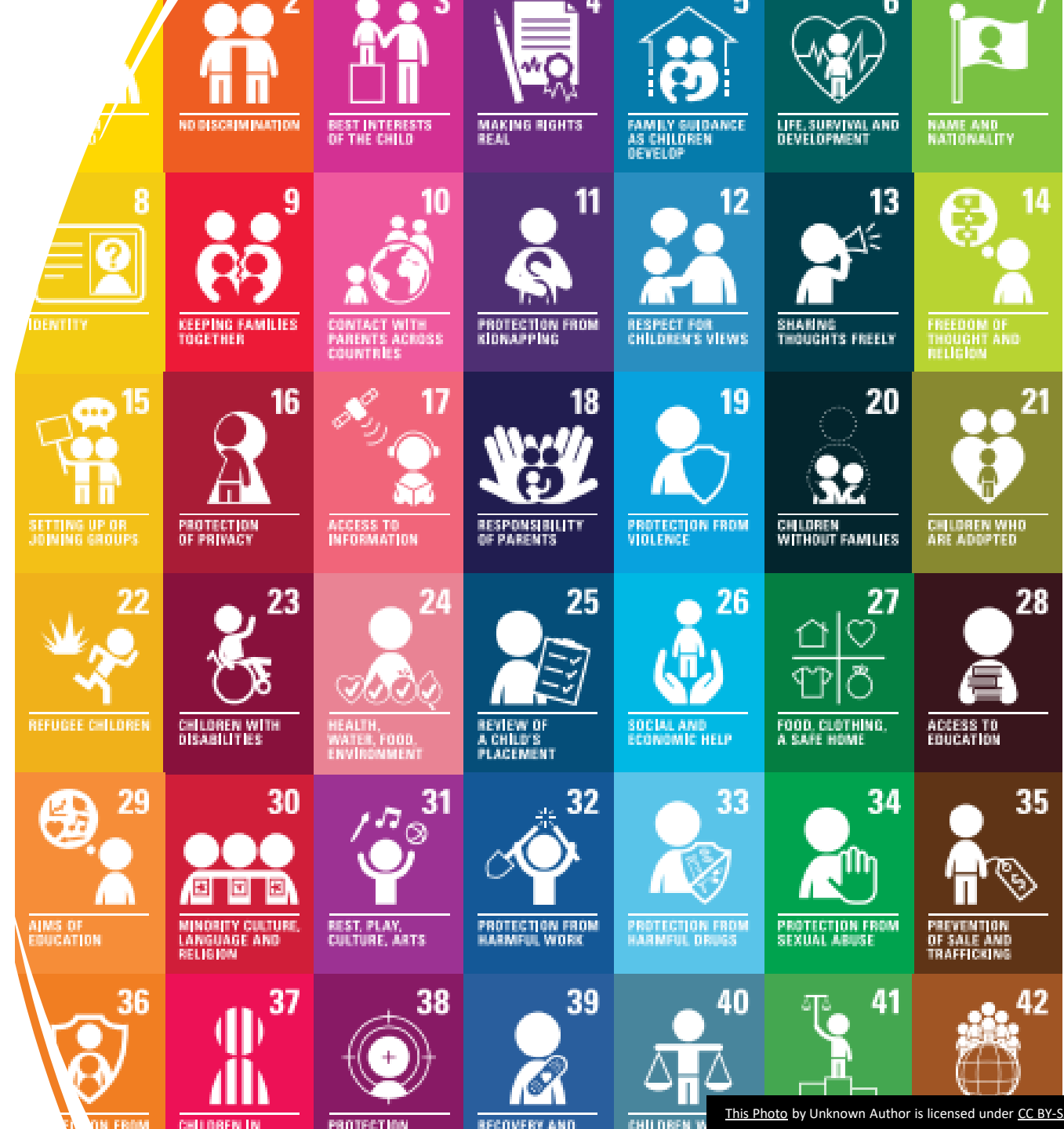


What are our rights?
