## Work Experience Programme 2018 - 2019

Pupils are required to submit the paperwork <u>4 weeks in advance</u> of the placement commencing.

Pupils approved for a work experience placement are expected to plan their time out of school and request school work to complete during their placement. It is the responsibility of pupils to ensure that they complete any coursework missed during their placement on their return to school.
