# SCHOOL /COLLEGE/ NLC OPTIONS FORM

## Vocational Pathways

This year we have focussed on providing vocational education in line with the vocational pathways that are determined by using labour market information. We have tried to create pathways that appeal to as many of our pupils as possible and to offer as broad an experience as possible, allowing pupils studying from SCQF Level 4 to Level 7 to access these courses.

## Progression

Working with partners we are also focussing on progressions from the vocational pathways. There are links with New College Lanarkshire and the University of West of Scotland for next level courses, Modern Apprenticeships and Graduate Apprenticeships and support for application and recruitment processes. Our colleagues at North Lanarkshire Academies are also working hard to create summer employment opportunities for all pupils and for pupils participating in vocational education. These opportunities are linked to the vocational pathways and will be communicated to our pupils in January. Support will be in place to apply for and participate in the recruitment process from January each year, we expect our pupils to do well in this process given their vocational experience. Pupils will gain an employability award during their employment and there will also be links to jobs, Modern Apprenticeship and college recruitment at the end of the summer employment with extended support for those that may need it.

HNCs take place 12 periods per week across D and E- Monday & Wednesday Face to face, Tuesday and Thursday online and Friday all day on campus. Level 6 Foundation Apprenticeships are delivered over 1 year in the same model as HNCs. Automotive in D and E is in Bold denoting **full day delivery only** on a Friday.  
**Please note: Some subjects may not run based on uptake, staffing and resource.**

### COURSE TITLE – HOSPITALITY LEVEL – LEVEL 5

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Pupils will be expected to have an interest and a passion for cookery/bakery. No formal qualifications are required for applying for the course above.

**COURSE DETAILS -** This course will provide you with skills and knowledge required to work in the kitchen and in front of house operations within catering/hospitality establishments. You will get an introduction to customer service, food hygiene, health and safety so you can apply these in your practical activities

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**The units, once achieved, will allow you to seek employment within the industry or progression onto the next level of a professional cookery and bakery college course

# COLUMN B

## **COURSE TITLE – ENGINEERING LEVEL – LEVEL 6**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Recommended: Level 5/Higher Graphical Communications, Design & Manufacture, Mathematics, English, Physics, Engineering Science or Practical Electronics at grade C or above.

**COURSE DETAILS** - Engineering is rapidly evolving, demanding highly skilled professionals. This qualification aims to equip learners with the necessary skills and knowledge to excel in this field. Through a project-based approach, learners will develop technical expertise, problem-solving abilities, and teamwork skills. They will engage in hands-on projects, utilizing both traditional and modern engineering techniques to design, manufacture, and test innovative solutions. By combining creativity, technical skill, and critical thinking, learners will be well-prepared to contribute to the future of engineering

**CAREER PROGRESSION-** University or college engineering courses

## **COURSE TITLE – BUSINESS SKILLS**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 6**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Three relevant National 5 passes, including English.

**COURSE DETAILS** - The subjects studied provide the fundamental knowledge and skills relating to the study of business and information technology, as well as allowing for choice and personalisation. It allows for progression to other business and/or IT related programmes in both the further and higher education sector, as well as providing progression within or to employment.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**Completion of the NPA along with one Higher in another subject will allow progression to the HNC Business, HNC Administration and IT or HNC Marketing with Public Relations and Advertising at New College Lanarkshire.

## **COURSE TITLE – INTRO TO SCOTS LAW**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 6**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Three relevant National 5 passes, including English.

**COURSE DETAILS** - The award consists of two mandatory units which are part of the NC in Legal Services. This award would be of particular value to pupils in their final year of schooling who are seeking to broaden their understanding of law and society, perhaps with a view to studying Scots law at college or university

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**Completion of the NPA along with one Higher in a Social subject will allow progression to the HNC Legal Services at New College Lanarkshire.

## **COURSE TITLE – BEAUTY**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 5**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Age 16+(subject to course design and delivery, this may be flexible) due to health and safety legislation for some of the treatments.

**COURSE DETAILS** - The course will provide pupils with an insight and qualifications into the Beauty related industry. They will develop skills that will allow working in the industry as a junior therapist and further study at higher level. Practical elements of the course will be carried out and assessed in a realistic working environment on peers and clients. Theoretical elements will be a combination of open-book written assignments and closed book assessments. Pupils are expected to perform, receive treatments on their peers and work with real-life clients.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**Further study in VRQ Level 2 (SCQF Level 5) or Access to HNC (SCQF Level 6 & 7) in Beauty Therapy for pupils that are more academically capable and prepared.

## COURSE TITLE – HAIRDRESSING

LEVEL – LEVEL 4

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Applicants for this course must have a keen interest in Hairdressing and have a level of general education required for SCQF Level 4.

**COURSE DETAILS -** The focus is on experiencing the salon environment and developing vocational skills, knowledge and understanding. Candidates will develop their skills in shampooing, conditioning, basic scalp massage, styling hair and basic hair colouring. They will learn about current fashion trends, with the opportunity to experiment to produce an image that reflects these. Emphasis throughout all Units is on employability skills and attitudes.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-** Introduction to NQ Hairdressing at New College Lanarkshire or employment in a hairdressing salon as a Trainee Hairdresser



## **COURSE TITLE – FITNESS, HEALTH AND EXERCISE**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 6**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Pupils must be working towards National 5 qualifications in 5 subjects, a PE qualification would be desirable.

**COURSE DETAILS -** This course covers various aspect of fitness such as how to develop cardiovascular endurance as well as how to design and deliver circuits whilst refining technical performance in free weight exercises

**CAREER PROGRESSION-** Potential entry to Level 6 NQ Sport and Fitness or HNC NextGen Physical Activity and Health/HNC Fitness Health and Exercise (with additional qualifications at Higher Level)

## **COURSE TITLE – DENTAL**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 6**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Three National 5s or equivalent, one of which should be English

**COURSE DETAILS -** Learners will attend the Coatbridge Campus for one day per week and will gain 'hand's on' experience via simulated learning within state-of-the art clinical teaching rooms. The theory which underpins the role of a student dental nurse will also be delivered at the campus and this consists of specialist modules which are continually assessed.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-** Modern apprenticeship employment opportunities as a student dental nurse plus articulation onto the HNC in Dental. Long term career prospects are as a dental practice manager, dental, radiographer, health promotion officer or dental hygienist/dental therapist.

## **COURSE TITLE – CYBER SECURITY**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 6**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** There are a number of formal and informal qualifications that would help to prepare learners: Police Scotland Cyber Security Badge, Security Fundamentals Unit at SCQF level, National 4/5 and Higher Computing Science

**COURSE DETAILS -** This SCQF level 6 NPA is designed to introduce the foundation knowledge and skills in cyber security. It is envisaged that candidates will gain experience and a thirst for more in depth study of this discipline . The knowledge and skills you will develop focus on: Data Security, Ethical Hacking, Digital Forensics

**CAREER PROGRESSION-** Successful candidates will be considered for entry to any HNC programme of study in Computing and Digital Technologies at New College Lanarkshire. Additional qualifications and an interview may be required for some disciplines.

## **COURSE TITLE – MUSIC TECHNOLOGY**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 6**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Music Technology Level 5 or equivalent.

**COURSE DETAILS -** The Music Technology Course at SCQF level 6 enables learners to develop and enhance their skills in the use of music technology to capture and manipulate audio. Learners will use music technology creatively within various sound production projects whilst developing a broad understanding of the music industry itself.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-** A variety of options from NQ to HND dependent on the level of qualification studied.

### **COURSE TITLE – EARLY LEARNING AND CHILDCARE**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 5**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Candidates should be working towards or have gained a minimum of at least three National 5 subjects, one of which should be English.

**COURSE DETAILS -** Learners will be introduced to children's development from 0-16 years of age and will explore the sequences and patterns of development and how they interrelate with each other. Learners will research the needs of children and the ways in which various factors may impact upon the development of the child. Learners will develop an understanding of how children benefit from a range of play opportunities through planning, participation and review of a wide range of different types of play experiences. A focus on the health and safety needs of children will be explored.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**Further study of NC Childhood Practice (level 6) or HNC Childhood Practice (minimum 2 Highers one must be C or above in English).  
Career options would include Play worker, Early Years' Support Worker, Early Years Practitioner

### **COURSE TITLE – HAIRDRESSING**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 5**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Applicants for this course must have a keen interest in Hairdressing and have a level of general education required for SCQF Level 5.

**COURSE DETAILS -** Candidates will develop their skills in shampooing, conditioning, basic scalp massage, styling hair and basic hair colouring. They will learn about current fashion trends, with the opportunity to experiment to produce an image that reflects these. Emphasis throughout all Units is on employability skills and attitudes.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**SVQ Level 5 or NQ/NC Level 5 Hairdressing at New College Lanarkshire with eventual progress to SVQ Level 3 or HNC Hairdressing or employment in a hairdressing salon as a Trainee Hairdresser.

### **COURSE TITLE – HOSPITALITY**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 5**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Pupils will be expected to have an interest and a passion for cookery/bakery. No formal qualifications are required for applying for the course above.

**COURSE DETAILS -** This course will provide you with skills and knowledge required to work in the kitchen and in front of house operations within catering/hospitality establishments. You will get an introduction to customer service, food hygiene, health and safety so you can apply these in your practical activities

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**The units, once achieved, will allow you to seek employment within the industry or progression onto the next level of a professional cookery and bakery college course

### **COURSE TITLE – BEAUTY**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 4**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** A keen and positive interest in the Beauty Industry with enthusiasm to promote and develop professional communication skills. Have the ability to work independently and as part of a team. Have an openness to learn.

**COURSE DETAILS -** This course is levelled at SCQF Level 4 which will enable pupils to develop basic beauty techniques relating to own personal care, appearance and that of their peers. This will give a good basic insight into the Beauty related industry. They will develop skills that will be beneficial in the promotion of appearance, wellbeing and skills to allow them steps to further develop in beauty treatments.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-** Further study in VRQ Level 1 (SCQF Level 4) or Level 2 (SCQF level 5) in Beauty Therapy.

## **COURSE TITLE – HNC SOCIAL SCIENCES**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 7**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Two Highers preferred; English and/or Social Science subjects also preferred- such as History, Modern Studies, Geography, RMPS, Psychology, Sociology, Politics or Philosophy.

**COURSE DETAILS -** This popular course is for those who are interested in people and society, and who want to develop their knowledge and understanding of Social Science subjects. There are a wide range of degree opportunities in a number of academic areas (including History, Politics, Sociology, Psychology and Criminology amongst others).

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**HND Social Science Year 2 at New College Lanarkshire.

## **COURSE TITLE – HNC SOCIAL SERVICES**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 7**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Working towards relevant National Qualifications or Equivalent NPAs at Levels 5 or 6 and/or recommendation from pupil support teacher.

**COURSE DETAILS -** Suitable for those interested in a career as a carer, social worker, addiction worker, team leader or in nursing. Learning Disability Nursing and Adult Nursing as well as Social Work and a host of other social services opportunities. The course is a combination of taught units and workplace experience, and as such it is very much "hands-on."

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**The HNC is a stand along registerable qualification with the SSSC but also leads to progression on to our BSc Collaborative Health and Social Care - year 2 in collaboration with UWS. Many of our HNC Students also go on to study towards Social Work, Nursing, Psychology and various other degree routes

## **COURSE TITLE – HNC COMPUTER AIDED DESIGN**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 7**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** One Higher. It would also be advantageous to have Nat 5 Design for Manufacture or Graphic Communications.

**COURSE DETAILS -** Some of the skills you will develop include: 2D draughting to British International standards : Knowledge of the design process working through live team projects : 3D software packages used in the engineering, manufacturing and construction industries : 3D Printing and scanning technologies and visualisation software

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**HND at New College Lanarkshire before moving on to a guaranteed 3rd year degree place at UWS.

## **COURSE TITLE – HNC CYBER SECURITY**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 7**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Working towards relevant National Qualifications (Computer Science, Maths, Sciences) or equivalent NPAs at Levels 5 or 6.

**COURSE DETAILS -** Some of the skills you will develop include: Operating system configuration, Computer networking configuration, Ethical hacking , Digital forensics, Data security, Coding , Legal and ethical implications

**CAREER PROGRESSION -** Successful candidates are guaranteed a place on 2nd and subsequently 3rd Year BEng Cyber Security degree at New College Lanarkshire through the undergraduate school partnership with UWS.

## **COURSE TITLE – HNC BUSINESS**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 7**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Working towards or achieved relevant National Qualifications at level 6 (English, Business Management or any social subject e.g. History, Geography, Modern Studies), or equivalent NPAs at level 6.

**COURSE DETAILS -** The HNC introduces the key functions in a business organisation. This qualification covers areas such as: Accounting for Business, Economic Issues, Managing People and Organisations, Marketing, IT and Business Fundamentals with Emerging Technologies.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**You can progress to the HND Business at New College Lanarkshire before moving on to a guaranteed 3rd year degree place on our B.A. Business and Sustainability (delivered in collaboration with UWS).

## **COURSE TITLE – HNC CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 7**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** One Higher. It would also be advantageous to have Nat 5 Graphic Communications or Design Manufacture.

**COURSE DETAILS -** Some of the skills you will develop include: Construction materials and specifications ;Building measurement and cost studies ; Building science : Construction technology; Industrial/commercial superstructure ; Building services: An introduction ; 2D CAD (Computer Aided Design) ;Health and safety in construction

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**HND at New College Lanarkshire before moving on to a guaranteed 3rd year degree place at UWS.

## **COURSE TITLE – FA CREATIVE AND DIGITAL MEDIA**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 6**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** A keen interest in photography, digital design or film making.

**COURSE DETAILS -** Creating digital content enables marketing, advertising or information gathering and in turn, produces a vast amount of job roles within the Creative Industries. Pupils will learn hard technical skills such as camera work, lighting, editing and sound as well as the important soft skills such as working in a team and managing to a deadline.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**NQ Film & Photography , HNC Television Production (with 2 Highers) , HNC Animation , HNC Photography

## **COURSE TITLE – FA IT SOFTWARE**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 6**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Working towards relevant National Qualifications (Computer Science, Maths, Sciences) or equivalent NPAs at Levels 5 and/or recommendation from pupil support teacher.

**COURSE DETAILS -** An FA in Software Development is the same level of learning as an SQA Higher (SCQF level 6). This includes:

- A National Progression Award (NPA) in Software Development at SCQF level 6
- Core units of a Diploma for IT & Telecommunications Professionals at SCQF level 6
- A work placement

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**A guaranteed place on HNC Computing at NCL , A Modern Apprenticeship in IT and Telecoms , A Graduate Apprenticeship in Software Development, Articulation to a university degree programme (with other relevant qualifications)

## **COURSE TITLE – FA CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 6**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Two National 5's, one of which must be English, and a competency in Maths.

**COURSE DETAILS -** Safeguarding of children and young people. Play for children and young people. Communication with children and young people. Development of children and young people. Promote the wellbeing and safety of children and young people

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**A Level 6 course, Modern Apprenticeship, or with additional qualifications (Higher English) progression to HNC in Childhood Practice or employment as a Support Worker.

## **COURSE TITLE – FA HEALTHCARE**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 6**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Two National 5 qualifications, one of which must be English and a competency in Maths.

**COURSE DETAILS -** People are at the heart of healthcare and social services. If you have a passion for improving lives and helping others, a career in this rewarding field could be for you. An FA in Social Services and Healthcare helps you prepare for a wide range of different care roles, Over 161,000 people are currently employed by NHS Scotland. The number of jobs is still growing, and there are great opportunities for progression.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**Some students secure employment directly within the Care sector. You can also progress to HNC Healthcare Practice or HNC Social Services as well as other Higher Education programmes within the college.

## **COURSE TITLE – FA CIVIL ENGINEERING (TIGERS)**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 6**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** aimed at pupils with an interest and enthusiasm in exploring this area of work. Although set at SCQF L6, due to the contextualised learning experience where underpinning theory and practice are aligned with industry, learners operating at SCQF L5 or above on arrival are encouraged.

**COURSE DETAILS -** You will Learn about materials, mechanics, mathematics, site work, site surveying and health and safety, AutoCAD, project management as well as emerging industry topics such as Digital engineering, sustainability and mental health in Construction, to stay on top of the game.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-** Foundation Apprenticeship in Civil Engineering is as an eligible qualification towards Higher National provision, towards under-graduate degrees and graduate apprenticeship provision, alongside other qualifications.

## **COURSE TITLE – FA CONSTRUCTION**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 5**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** A keen interest in the construction industry.

**COURSE DETAILS -** Your National Progression Award will cover a variety of units and may include: Bricklaying, Carpentry and bench joinery, Painting and decorating

You will use the skills and knowledge you develop in your National Progression Award to successfully complete the work-based challenge unit and develop an understanding of the construction sector.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**An apprenticeship or progression on to a college course.

### **COURSE TITLE – HOSPITALITY**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 5**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Pupils will be expected to have an interest and a passion for cookery/bakery. No formal qualifications are required for applying for the course above.

**COURSE DETAILS -** This course will provide you with skills and knowledge required to work in the kitchen and in front of house operations within catering/hospitality establishments. They will develop skills that will allow working in the industry as a junior therapist and further study at higher level. Practical elements of the course will be carried out and assessed in a realistic working environment on peers and clients. Theoretical elements will be a combination of open-book written assignments and closed book assessments. Pupils are expected to perform, receive treatments on their peers and work with real-life clients.

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Interest in theatre and performance.

**COURSE DETAILS -** This dynamic course is perfect for young creatives who want to:

- Step into the spotlight with theatre and performance
- Experiment with music and audio production
- Get hands-on with video creation and editing

Through fun, practical projects, you'll gain a taste of the skills and techniques that power these vibrant industries. Whether you dream of producing a hit podcast, filming your first blockbuster, or designing stunning stage productions, this course is your first step.

Get inspired, get creative, and get ready for an unforgettable journey that prepares you for the next level in creative education.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-** Further study at SCQF level 5

### **COURSE TITLE – AUTOMOTIVE**

**LEVEL – LEVEL 4**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Must be in 4th year of high school with a keen interest in joining the automotive industry.

**COURSE DETAILS -** The candidates will learn the structure of a dealership, how to work as part of the garage structure, how to prepare a vehicle for sale (valeting), and how to carry out basic maintenance tasks while using automotive tools and equipment. The candidates strip down engines and components, complete mock interviews, CV building, and general confidence building. We have introduced electric and hybrid vehicle awareness training as well as hydrogen vehicle technologies.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**opportunity for progression to a Modern apprenticeship within one of our automotive programs. This could be mechanical, body repair and paint, parts, or customer service.

## COURSE TITLE – HOSPITALITY

LEVEL – LEVEL 4

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-** Pupils will be expected to have an interest and a passion for cookery/bakery. No formal qualifications are required for applying for the course above.

**COURSE DETAILS -** The units will consist of a mixture of bakery and cookery outcomes and is designed to develop your planning, preparation, problem solving, teamwork and working on your own initiative. The course will provide you with skills and knowledge required to work in a professional kitchen within catering/hospitality establishments. You will get an introduction to customer service, food hygiene, health and safety so you can apply these in your practical activities.

**CAREER PROGRESSION-**The units, once achieved, will allow you to seek employment within the industry or progression onto the next level of a professional cookery and bakery college course.

## **COURSE TITLE – HOSPITALITY LEVEL – LEVEL 5**
