## Design Factors

Your teacher has already explained what Design Factors are. If you can't remember, now would be a good time to remind yourself! Look in your workbook for the definition of design factors or go to www.airdrie.n-lanark.sch.uk.

One of the most important Design Factors is 'Function'. This describes the job of the object being designed.

Making something which has multiple uses means that you may be able to sell more of them! 2 functions could mean twice the sales!

A popular trick that designers use is to design something which solves more than one problem. This means the object has more than 1 function. It's 'Multi-Functional'!
