As your teacher has already explained to you, Design is a process. There are very specific steps or stages we go through when designing.

This homework exercise focuses on only one of the design stages namely 'Specification'.

This is the part of the design process where we create a **LIST OF RULES** which our design will follow. These rules are based on an 'Analysis' which should have already been carried out on the 'Design Factors'.

We want you to look at the 'Brief' and 'Analysis' on the following pages and then complete the 'Specification'

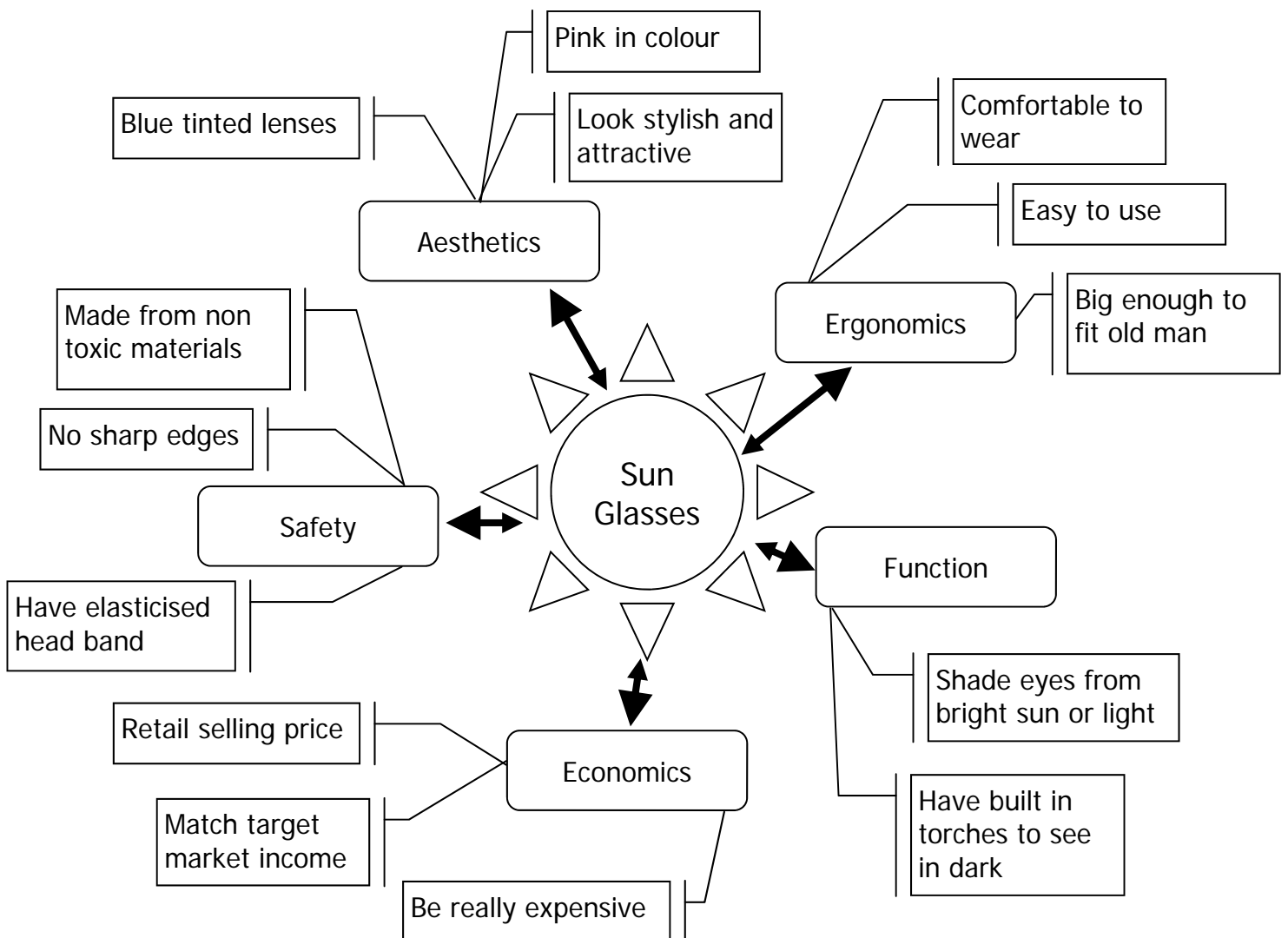
WARNING!
