Traffic Old Edinburgh Road

Councillor Helen Loughran recapped regarding the ongoing speeding problems on Old Edinburgh Road which did not meet the criteria for a pedestrian crossing to be put in place. Helen has now put forward recommendations for an Island Crossing to be put in place at Second Street and asked for the speed limit to be reduced to help calm traffic from the top of the S bend on Old Edinburgh Road next to local shops, along to the small roundabout after Second Street. Helen explained there are many factors involved in such decisions, including budgets and the width of the road, this must be able to accommodate enough space for prams, wheelchairs as well as pedestrians. As of last week, this has been tasked to an external organisation. They will complete a survey of the area and once the data has been collected this will be fed back to the Road Traffic Team from North Lanarkshire Council. Helen to update. Estimated timescale is

5. Principal Teacher's Report

We've had a positive start to the year. Our Primary 1's has settled well, there are twenty-three pupils this year. Primary 7 are enjoying their additional responsibilities, Captains/Vice Captains will be selected prior to the September weekend. We have a new member of staff, Kelsey McCartney, for NCCT and additional support.

Our PEF is being used again to allow Mrs Devine and Mrs McGregor to be non-class committed and provide Literacy and Numeracy support across the school which is beneficial to the children. Our Leadership Academies are starting tomorrow. This year we have eight: Responsible Reading Stars, Eco Warriors, Enterprising Entrepreneurs, Rights Rockstars, Play Leaders, Sports Leaders, Digital Ambassadors, STEM Leaders and Wellbeing Warriors. If anyone could provide any guidance or assistance to any of our groups, it would be gratefully received. We have two parents joining the Responsible Reading Stars which is great. They meet every 3rd Friday afternoon, starting tomorrow. The Pupil Council is going to operate separately to this and will meet with myself or Alison throughout the year. Each class will have the opportunity to vote for two Pupil Council Representatives and the children will also have the chance to choose their House Captains and Vice Captains before the September weekend.
