Learning Conversations - Information for Parents/Carers

At Alexander Peden, we recognise the importance of working together with parents/carers to support and challenge our children to be the best they can possibly be. Research shows that children attain so much more when parents/carers are involved in their child's learning. Learning Conversations are a great way for parents/carers to do exactly that. Every term there is the opportunity for parents/carers, alongside their child to meet with the class teacher to review progress to date, identify next steps in learning and explore ideas to support learning at home.

How Does It Work?

- On-line booking is opened prior to each term Learning Conversation – parents/carers choose their preferred time
- Learning Conversations are hosted over two days and offer after school & evening appointments
- Each Learning Conversation lasts 15 minutes
- It is important that your child attends the Learning Conversation with their parent/carer as personal learning targets will be agreed
- Currently all our Learning Conversations are digital – video call
