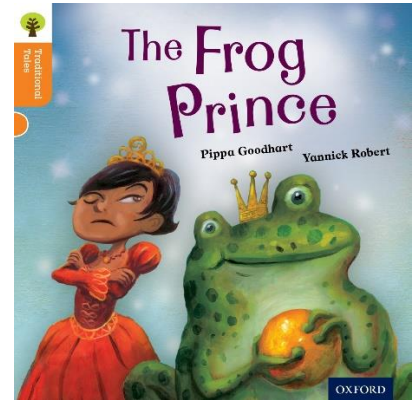

Look at the front cover.

You can enlarge the picture by clicking on the corner and dragging it.

Here are some questions you can ask before you read the book.

Who is the author? There are two names. Do you think one person may have a different job? What could it be?

What do you think the story is about?

Who do you think the girl is? Why do you think that?

Look at her face! How do you think she looks/feels?

Does the frog have the same expression?

Log on to https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/digital_books/1403.html

and read the story aloud to someone at home. Remember to read the blurb on the back cover first!

Pay attention to the information on the inside of the front cover. There are lots of ideas and helpful tips.

After you have read the story you can listen to it.

At the top of the page there are two tabs each with an activity for you to complete. These are fun and quick to complete. You don't have to write them down.

Activity 1 allows you to put some sentences in the correct order. Think which sentence should be at the beginning of the story. Click on the sentence you want to move and drag it to the top of the page.

Activity 2 is asking you to read a sentence but 1 word has the ending missing. Read the endings in the boxes and say the word with the different endings. Which one sounds right? When you have decided on the correct ending click on it and drag it to where the missing word is.

For your written task today you will need a piece of paper. A writing pencil and some colouring pencils or pens.

Task 1 Do you like the illustration on the front cover?

Talk about what you like or maybe don't!

I would like you to create a new front cover using your favourite part of the story.

Task 2 The blurb on the back cover of the book is very simple and effective. Re-write it by adding a few more sentences to make it more exciting. You can write it on the back of your illustration or underneath it.

Use the book to help with your spelling.

Remember capital letters and full stops.
