

Numeracy



So far this term, Room 3 have been developing their knowledge of shape, position and movement. The children have been engaging in a range of active and engaging activities to explore 2D and 3D shapes, symmetry, angles and directions.

Progressing on through the term, the Decagons and Octagons will explore Algebraic Thinking, where they will be developing their knowledge of patterns, function machines and simple equations. The Hexagons and Pentagons will consolidate their knowledge of Fractions and begin to revise the four operations, Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division.



Literacy

This term, we will continue to develop our spelling skills by using our spelling strategies and phonetic knowledge to spell common and tricky words.

We will be reading a range of fiction texts to improve our fluency and comprehension skills. Pupils will use the comprehension strategies to develop a deeper understanding of their group reading books. Later in the term, we will apply our comprehension strategies to poetry to show our understanding of different text types.



P4/5 are developing their persuasive writing skills using a variety of contexts for writing. Ask your children about the arguments they have been persuading their audience of and see if they can persuade you too!



Interdisciplinary Learning

Room 3 are bursting on to the political scene this term, just in time for election season, as we begin our Class Elections topic. While learning about the Scottish Government and the election process, we will be
