P7 Outdoor Education Week

Our P7 pupils have the opportunity to attend a week of outdoor education at Strathclyde Park again this year. We are timetabled to go from Monday 31^{st} October – Friday 4^{th} November and cost is £108 which includes transport to and from school and lunch at the park. A payment has been set up on iPay which can be made in instalments and can be paid up until Monday 7^{th} November. P7s will bring home a paper consent form this week. Parent Council & Parent Forum

Auchinloch Primary and Nursery are so grateful for and rely on our Parent Council and Parent Forum. As a small school, we have a small budget so without parents' fundraising efforts, there are many activities and resources we simply couldn't pay for. Our Parent Council has had a solid membership for several years but as children have moved up through the school and in some cases on to high school, we have lost many of our stalwart members. Covid restrictions have also meant the opportunities for events have been so few that most of our P1-3 parents will barely have set foot in the building.
