Bus Travel

As of Monday 31st August, it is compulsory for all children to wear a face covering on the Calvary Park and the KCC bus as per Government regulations. It is also the parent/carer's responsibility to make sure their child has sanitised their hands before going on school transport/Kids' Club transport. No food or drink should be consumed on the bus and parents/Carers will be notified if regulations are not adhered to.

School Photos

Flu

Physical Education

Class teachers have advised days for PE in class newsletters (outdoor at present for Health & Safety reasons). 2 hours PE is compulsory in Scotland and as such, pupils should come to school on their PE day wearing appropriate clothing. Only children with a medical condition/ restricted mobility (e.g) broken leg, will be exempt. A letter from the GP will be required if a child has a medical condition that will not allow them to take part in PE for an extended period of time. All children, unless particular circumstances prevent this, will be outside at their allocated PE time. Health and Wellbeing is a core curricular area; Social/Emotional/Mental/Physical.

General

It is, however, necessary to highlight that staff should not be subjected to any form of abuse or threats and these will be reported to the local authority if required.
