## PTA Minutes Wednesday 24th March 2021

- Finance Update: £3594.06 This amount is less than previously reported in January as the Halloween and Christmas Party money for the school still had to be deducted.
- Messages of Love review: good response from the school hub, poor overall response out
  with the school with some businesses not following up on initial request. PTA would still
  consider supporting some kind of 'whole' school display in the community at another
  time.
- P.1 Transition Teddies: PTA agreed to fund 'The Everywhere Bear' for the new P.1s. This
  is a keyring teddy that will be attached to their bag and give them comfort and hugs as
  they settle into school. Louise will purchase 60 (around £163) and Lynne will send a
  cheque to Louise when this is done. Teddies will have 'Balmalloch PS' sweatshirts on.
- P.1 Induction Day PTA presence this is not possible to arrange at this time due to current restrictions and no other adults being allowed inside the school.
- Uniform Orders/Swap Shop PTA Involvement: as above, we cannot arrange due to current restrictions.
- P.7 Hoodies- 3 pupils have not purchased their hoodie and the PTA have agreed to provide the funds. Janice will transfer £57 to Karen Maley to purchase and will advise Lynne when this is done, Lynne will write out a cheque for Janice.
- P.7 Beach Party: No lets are being booked at the moment due to current restrictions.
  Ruth has earmarked provisional dates for the Beach Party: Monday 21<sup>st</sup> June P.7a,
  Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> June P.7b as classes may need to stay within their bubbles. We will review
  the situation in May and decide if we can go ahead or support an alternative event for
  the P.7's

- Fund-raising ideas April-June PTA agreed that we would organise a Duck Race for each class w/c 18<sup>th</sup> June (as no Civic Week events will be taking place). PTA will organise flyer and info at least 2 weeks before and will arrange a 'Design a Duck' competition in advance, with winning pupils getting a free the duck race. PTA will inform parents/carers of event and cost no later than 1<sup>st</sup> June to give plenty of advance warning. Suggested price 1 duck for £2, 2 ducks for £3, 4 ducks for £4. This will benefit families with more than 1 child at the school. PTA will arrange prizes and we can decide nearer the time who will run the races in school.
