Workwear Guidance:

All staff must maintain an acceptable and professional standard of dress whilst at work. Staff should dress in a smart-casual attire.

- Examples of acceptable clothing are as follows; trousers, shirts, blouses, smart t-shirts, jumpers, jackets etc.
- Black jeans and jeggings may be worn as long as these are plain black with no rips, tears, designs, prints or patterns.
- NLC policy stipulates that no football colours should be worn.
- Staff should also be mindful that open toed shoes and stiletto heels are not appropriate for the playroom floor.
- Staff are reminded that short skirts/dresses, low cut tops/trousers, bare midriffs and transparent clothing items are not appropriate or acceptable on the playroom floor.

All staff should also wear either their Employee Identification badge or a visitor badge throughout their time in the nursery.

All students must also adhere to the above guidance and dress in an acceptable manner.
