<b>Article 2</b>	All children have these rights no matter who they are, where they live, what their parents/carers do, what language they speak, what their religion is, whether they are a boy or girl, what their culture is, whether they have a disability, whether they are rich or poor. No child should be treated unfairly on any basis.	<b>FAMILY &amp; LOVE</b>
<b>Article 12</b>	You have the right to give your opinion and for adults to listen and take it seriously.	<b>HONESTY &amp; RESPONSIBILITY</b>
<b>Article 15</b>	You have the right to choose your own friends and join or set up groups, as long as it isn't harmful to others.	<b>FRIENDSHIP FORGIVENESS</b>
<b>Article 16</b>	You have the right to privacy.	<b>RESPECT</b>
<b>Article 19</b>	You have the right to be protected from being hurt and mistreated, in body and mind.	<b>RESPONSIBILITY</b>
<b>Article 28</b>	You have the right to a good quality education. You should be encouraged to go to school to the highest level you can.	<b>PERSEVERANCE</b>
<b>Article 29</b>	Your education should help you use and develop your talents and abilities. It should help you learn to live peacefully, protect the environment and respect other people.	<b>RESPECT &amp; GRATITUDE</b>
<b>Article 31</b>	You have the right to play and rest.	<b>FRIENDSHIP &amp; GENEROSITY</b>
<b>Article 37</b>	No-one is allowed to punish you in a cruel or harmful way.	<b>LOVE &amp; RESPECT</b>
<b>Article 39</b>	You have the right to help if you are hurt, neglected or badly treated.	<b>LOVE &amp; RESPONSIBILITY</b>
