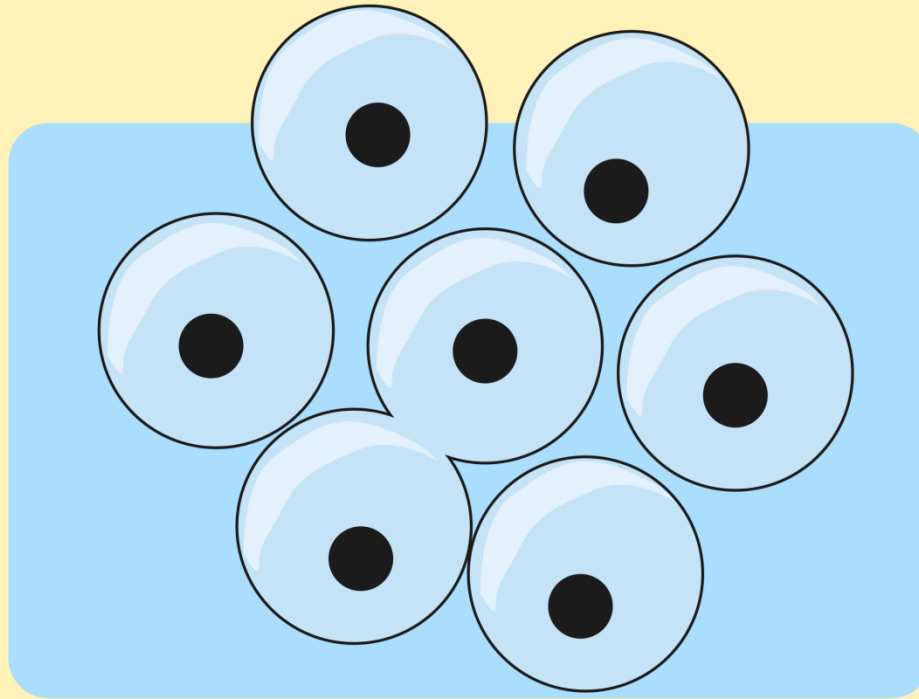



Frog Life Cycle



Frog eggs are laid in a group in the water by a frog. These eggs hatch into tadpoles.





The tadpole spends its time swimming in the water, eating and growing. Tadpoles have a tail for swimming with.



The tadpole sprouts legs (and then arms), has a longer body, and has a bigger head. It breathes under the water and still has a tail.



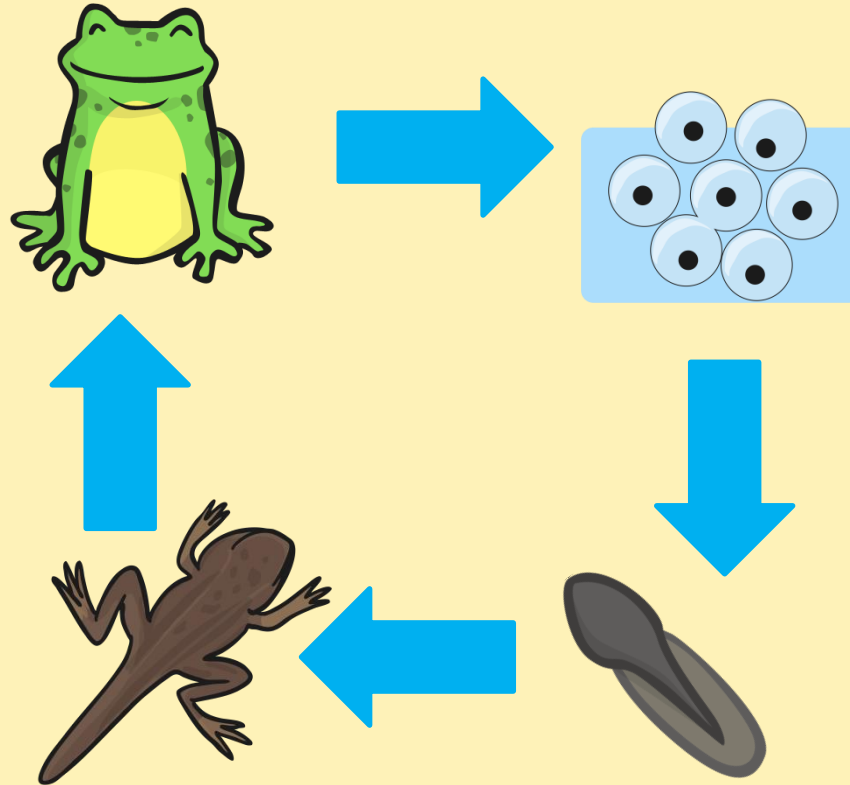
The adult frog breathes air and has no tail.
