I can solve addition word problems!

Read these sentences and turn them into addition chimney sums! Here is an example:

*I picked **41** apples on Monday. I also picked **5** apples on Tuesday. How many apples did I pick altogether?*

$$\begin{array}{r} 41 \\ + 5 \\ \hline 46 \end{array}$$

1. Juliet watched **12** episodes of *My Little Pony* in the morning and **3** episodes in the afternoon. How many altogether?
2. Lexi went **25** miles on a horse. Then she went another **4** miles. How far altogether?
3. Nathaniel saw **60** stars through at 6 o'clock, and then **9** stars at 8 o'clock. How many altogether?
4. Millie has **£21** and Chloe has **£8**. How much money do they have altogether?
5. Mr McNab got **77** Star Wars toys for his birthday and **2** for Christmas. How many toys altogether?
6. Xander made a lego tower with **70** bricks. Tony Alexander added on **8** bricks. How many bricks altogether?
7. It rained for **45** minutes yesterday and then **4** minutes today. How many minutes altogether?
8. Baby McNab needed his nappy changed **92** times in the morning and **7** times in the afternoon. How many times altogether?
