I can solve addition word problems!

Read these sentences and turn them into addition chimney sums! Here is an example:

*I picked **41** apples on Monday. I also picked **31** apples on Tuesday. How many apples did I pick altogether?*

$$\begin{array}{r} 41 \\ + 31 \\ \hline 72 \end{array}$$

1. Juliet watched **23** episodes of *My Little Pony* in the morning and **24** episodes in the afternoon. How many altogether?
2. Lexi went **55** miles on a horse. Then went another **32** miles. How far altogether?
3. Nathaniel saw **60** stars at 6 o'clock, and then another **25** stars at 8 o'clock. How many altogether?
4. Millie has **£44** and Chloe has **£44**. How much money do they have altogether?
5. Mr McNab got **27** Star Wars toys for his birthday and another **22** for Christmas. How many altogether?
6. Xander made a lego tower with **71** bricks. Tony Alexander added on **28** bricks. How many bricks altogether?
7. It rained for **45** minutes yesterday and then **41** minutes today. How many minutes altogether?
8. Baby McNab needed his nappy changed **53** times in the morning and **46** times in the afternoon. How many times did he need his nappy changed altogether?
