3. Nathaniel saw **69** stars through his telescope at 6pm, and then another **23** stars at 8pm. How many stars did he see altogether?
4. Millie has **£48** and Chloe has **£44**. How much money do they have altogether?
5. Mr McNab got **77** Star Wars toys for his birthday and another **16** for Christmas. How many toys did he get altogether?
6. Xander made a lego tower with **53** bricks. Tony Alexander added on **49** bricks. How many bricks were in the tower altogether?
7. It rained for **45** minutes yesterday and then **55** minutes today. How many minutes did it rain altogether?
8. Baby McNab needed his nappy changed **99** times in the morning and **99** times in the afternoon. How many times did he need his nappy changed altogether?
