I can identify and use higher and lower numbers

Look at each pair of numbers. Decide which number is higher, and which number is lower. Then, put them both into a subtraction chimney sum. Here is an example:

34
46

This number is **higher**, so it will go on the **top** of our chimney sum.

$$\begin{array}{r} 46 \\ - 34 \\ \hline 12 \end{array}$$

This number is **lower**, so it will go on the **bottom** of our chimney sum.
