

Make a Kilt for Robert Burns

1.

Choose one of the tartans below to make a kilt for Robert Burns or use the blank template to design your own!

Cut out the templates for your chosen kilt and sporran below.

3.

Concertina fold the dotted lines and gather them at the top corners behind the flat centre section, where the crosses are. Secure with a staple or piece of tape.

Do not staple at the bottom, instead slightly fan the bottom of the kilt out.

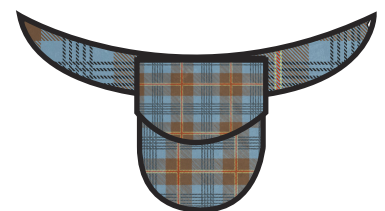
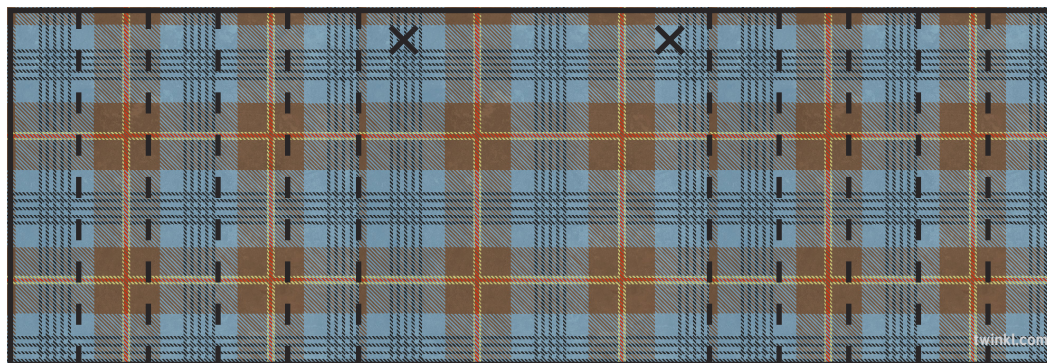
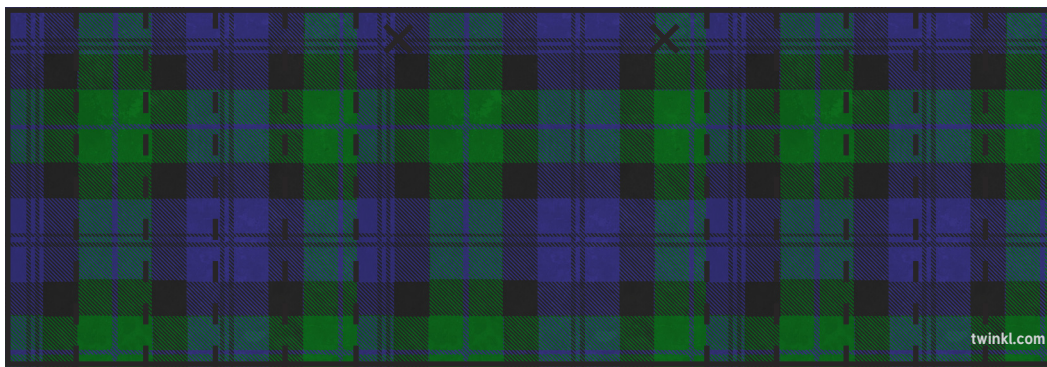
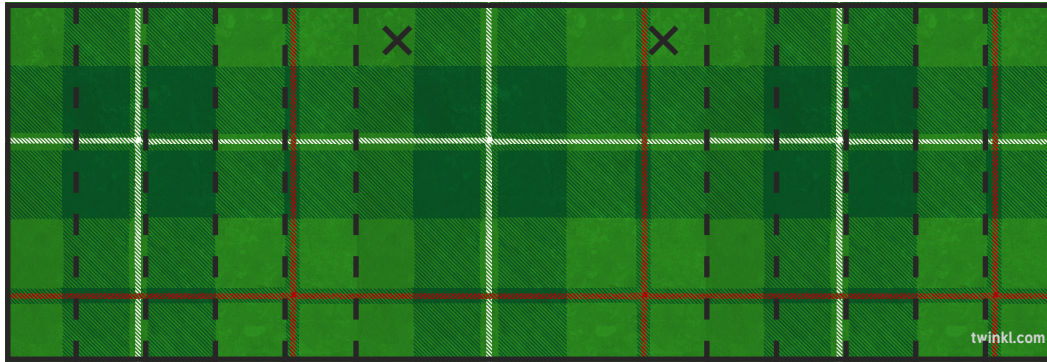
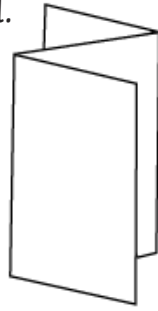

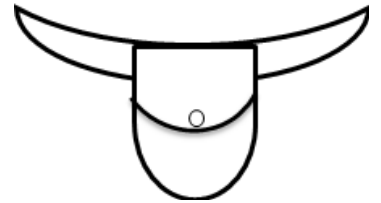
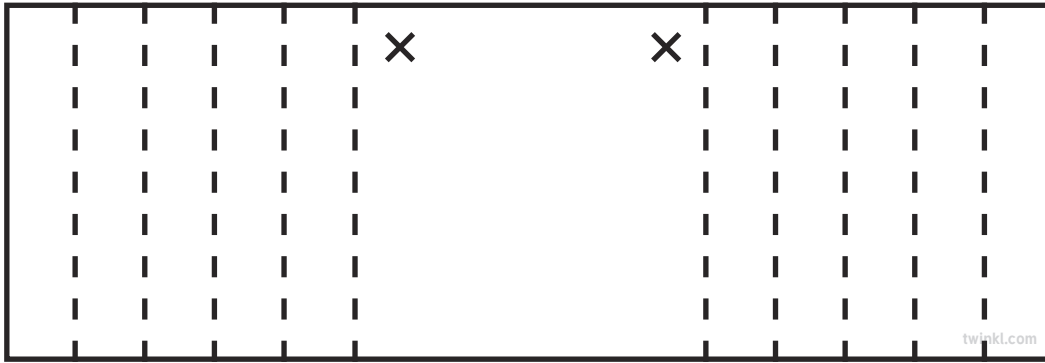
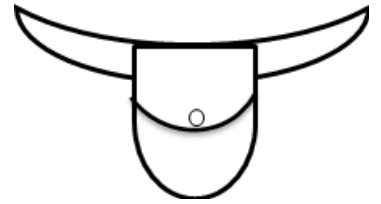
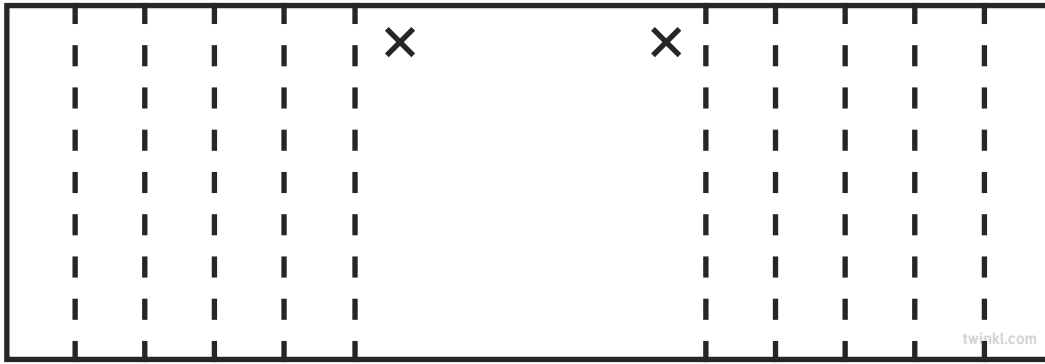
Next cut out and colour your sporran, sticking it over the crosses on the top of the kilt.

Now you are ready to stick your kilt on to the Robert Burns figure.

This is a concertina fold.
