First Level: Data and Analysis


Score Tracking

Play a game with someone in your family and keep a track of the score. You could play with 1, 2, 3 or 4 players. This could be Sumdog, Monopoly, Connect 4 or any game of your choice.

Create a table to keep track of everyone's scores. It could look something like this –

	Game 1	Game 2	Game 3	Game 4
Mary	50	43	38	49
Mum	43	44	45	34
Dad	47	39	28	27
John	29	31	32	30

Create a line graph to show the scores. You could have a different graph for each person or try to have a different line for each person on the same graph. It could look something like this —



What was the highest score?

Who got the highest score?

Who won the most number of games? What else does the graph tell you?
