<p><u>Outdoor Spelling</u> Go outside and see what you can find! Use sticks, stones, leaves - or anything that you can find to make your spelling words!</p>	<p><u>Invention</u> Invent a new product! Think about the cost of making the item and what it will do! Use your math skills to explain how the product will work and what materials that you will use to create it.</p>	<p><u>Challenge</u> Try to eat 3 new foods that you have never tried before! Think about the taste and the texture, ask someone at home for some suggestions!</p>	<p><u>Topic</u> Think about your favorite animal, what do they eat? Where would you find it in the wild? Create a fact file on it!</p>
<p><u>Spelling Jumble</u> Take some of your spelling or phoneme words and get someone at home to write them muddled up! See if you can figure the word - e.g. koohs - shook.</p>	<p><u>Angles</u> Use your surroundings to spot some right angles! Think about windows, tables, doors, chairs etc. Take a photo of the right angle that you spot!</p>	<p><u>Working with others -</u> Design your own club, where would it take place? What would everyone do at the club? Either write down a description or draw a picture of what would be going on.</p>	<p><u>Topic</u> Do some research! Have a look at the different types of footprints that animals have. Go outside and find some mud! Using a stick, see if you can draw a footprint...</p>
<p><u>Writing</u> Think about something that you know lots about... create an information report on it! It could be a game you know, a country, someone famous, space or an animal!</p>	<p><u>Time</u> Create a match up game - write down analogue and digital clock times, and then mix them up! Either on your own or with someone at home, match up the times!</p>	<p><u>Mindset</u> Draw your own plant - on its stem and leaves, write down some growth mindset quotes to encourage everyone to be the best that they can be! Use any colour that you like.</p>	<p><u>Topic</u>- Look after a plant! Either grow your own plant using seeds, or use one that you already have at home or in the garden! Feed and water, it for a week, and see how it turns out!</p>
<p><u>Visualisation</u> Create a visualiser of a character from either your reading book or a book that you are reading at home!</p>	<p><u>4 Operations</u> Create a snakes and ladders game using the 4 operations! You can include multiplication, division, addition and subtraction. You could even make a times table version!</p>	<p><u>Food -</u> Where does our food come from? Ask at home, and check the packaging on what you eat or make! What are the ingredients and where can we find it?</p>	<p><u>Topic -</u> Create a mini bug hotel! Use items like, pinecones, twigs, grass, stones, plastic bottles, toilet paper rolls or cardboard.</p>
<p><u>Poetry</u> Write a poem based on what you see, hear or feel! Either go outside or stay inside - and write a short poem about it.</p>	<p><u>Research</u> Do some research! Think about 3 mathematicians - or 3 famous inventors, how have they used math when creating their inventions? Do some research on them and create a poster!</p>	<p><u>PE -</u> Create your own sports day medal, think about the school logo and what your medal might look like. Create a design of your choice.</p>	<p><u>Responsible -</u> Think of what we do in school, how can we help protect the planet? Write a short song about the things that you can do!</p>
<p><u>Metalinguistics -</u> Think about a book that you have read or are going to read - choose 5 tricky words from the book, and use your strategies to work out what they mean!</p>	<p><u>Sumdog</u> Login to Sumdog and play for at least 15 minutes.</p>	<p>Help out at home! Catch up with people at home and see what you can help out with! This could be sorting the recycling or helping make dinner!</p>	<p><u>Topic -</u> Go out on a walk and make a list of all the animals that you spot! What kind of animal is it and where did you find it?</p>
<p><u>Assess your reading!</u> Either ask someone at home to listen, or record yourself reading, did you miss any words? Did you read too fast or too slow? Did you use tone and get into character?</p>	<p><u>Symmetry -</u> Have a look around your environment! What items can you see that are symmetrical? Put lines of symmetry on the item by drawing it or take a photo of it and using an app.</p>	<p><u>PE -</u> In preparation for sports day - practice running! Either use a clock, or ask someone at home to time you running 5 times and see when you were fastest!</p>	<p><u>Religion -</u> Research 2 religions that you would like to know more about, record information on them both, and the differences between them.</p>
