Head Teacher Report

Report received prior to meeting.

John is guest speaker at the Getting Better Together AGM so comments/questions on report first to let him get away early

Confirmed that uniforms from the return visit from Academy Uniforms were received this week.

Confirmed that we have a new construction Tutor – the college going above and beyond to handle previous issues and concerns to make sure the class can run successfully.

SQA – post results service, query as to whether the results of the reviews were normal (1 out of 23 for CHS) and confirmation that it is. Costing £10 for addition of marks to be checked not seen to be worthwhile for many subjects as the marking is computerised. A remark is £30 but Maxine explained the strict marking process which explained why there are so few successful appeals.

The sports/clubs timetable was questioned as it appears last years was issued – this includes Rugby but an interested pupil was told it was not in fact running this year, John confirmed this as in previous years no matter what the school has tried there has not been enough interest.

Lynn (1st year parent) queried the time of the upcoming parents night asking if this was always the time (4.30 to 6.30) as it must be unsuitable for many working parents. Confirmed that parents evenings for all year groups are at this tine – a few years previously evening parents nights were trialled however this had no impact on the number of parents attending. It was agreed that it is a good idea to include a note of the parents evening info in the P7 transition packs to give new high school parents some prior notice. Also pointed out that the school website is still showing last years Calender. Discussed possible Parent Council presence at next weeks parents night and Susan recalled preparing something previously on John's PC – John was able to find this before he had to leave, he will email to Linsey to be updated and printed.

Update on proposed exercise classes

Gordon visited the school yesterday with Alan yesterday and Mr Russell took some time to show him the PE hall etc. Feeling is the gym is not suitable as we are looking at young children being involved, found that there is not too much equipment in the PE hall so he may have to get imaginative and bring some of his own equipment. He feels a 4 week trial would be best and will get back with an idea of cost for this and an idea of how many paying people he would need to commit to it as an ongoing concern.
