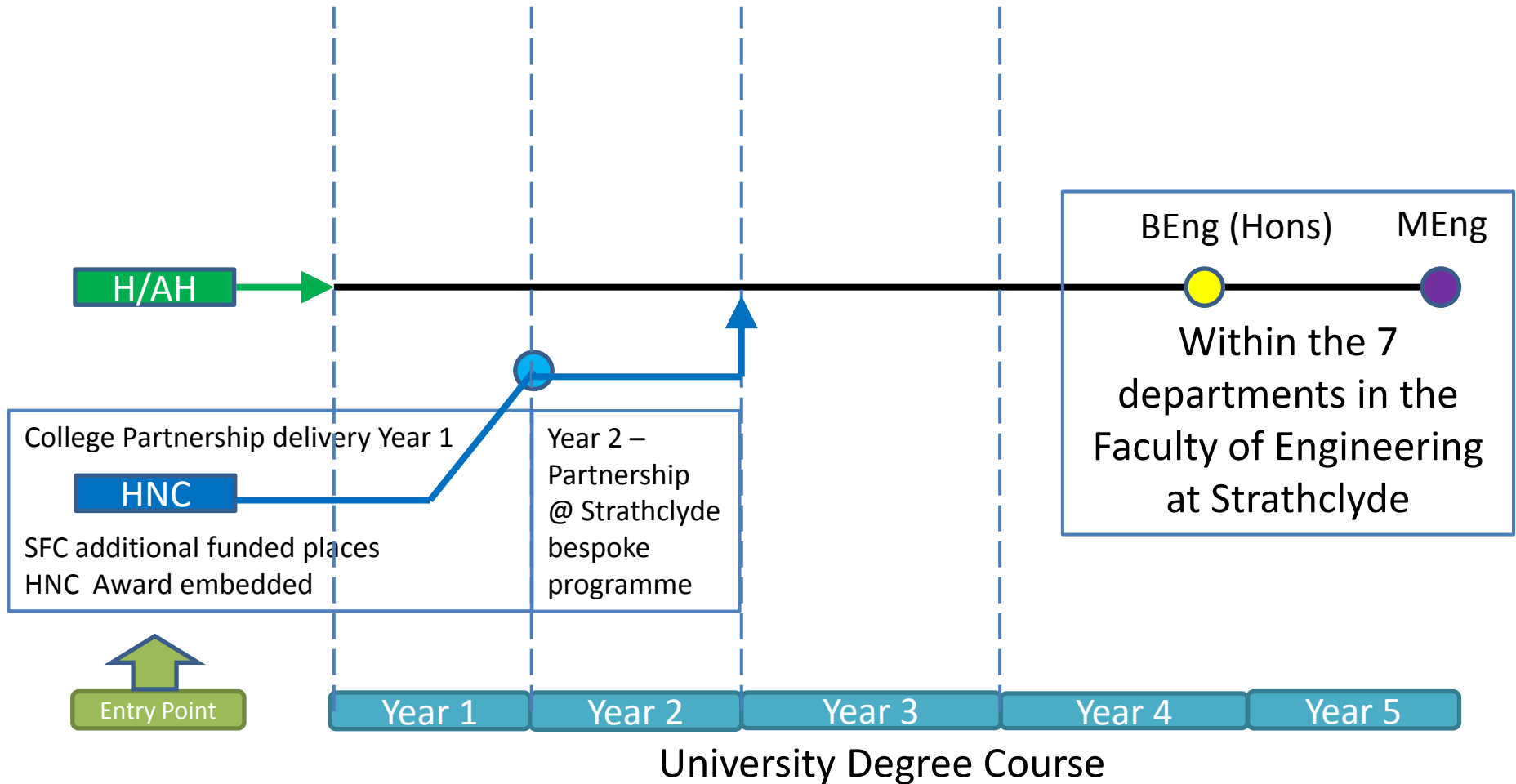
What is the Engineering Academy?

- Funded by the Scottish Funding Council
 - 105 student places
- Partnership between University of Strathclyde and a group of FE colleges with industry support with opportunities for:
 - Sponsorship
 - Work placements
 - Skills development programme
- Students study an enhanced HNC in college
- Guaranteed articulation to University course on satisfactory completion
 - Seven university departments in Engineering

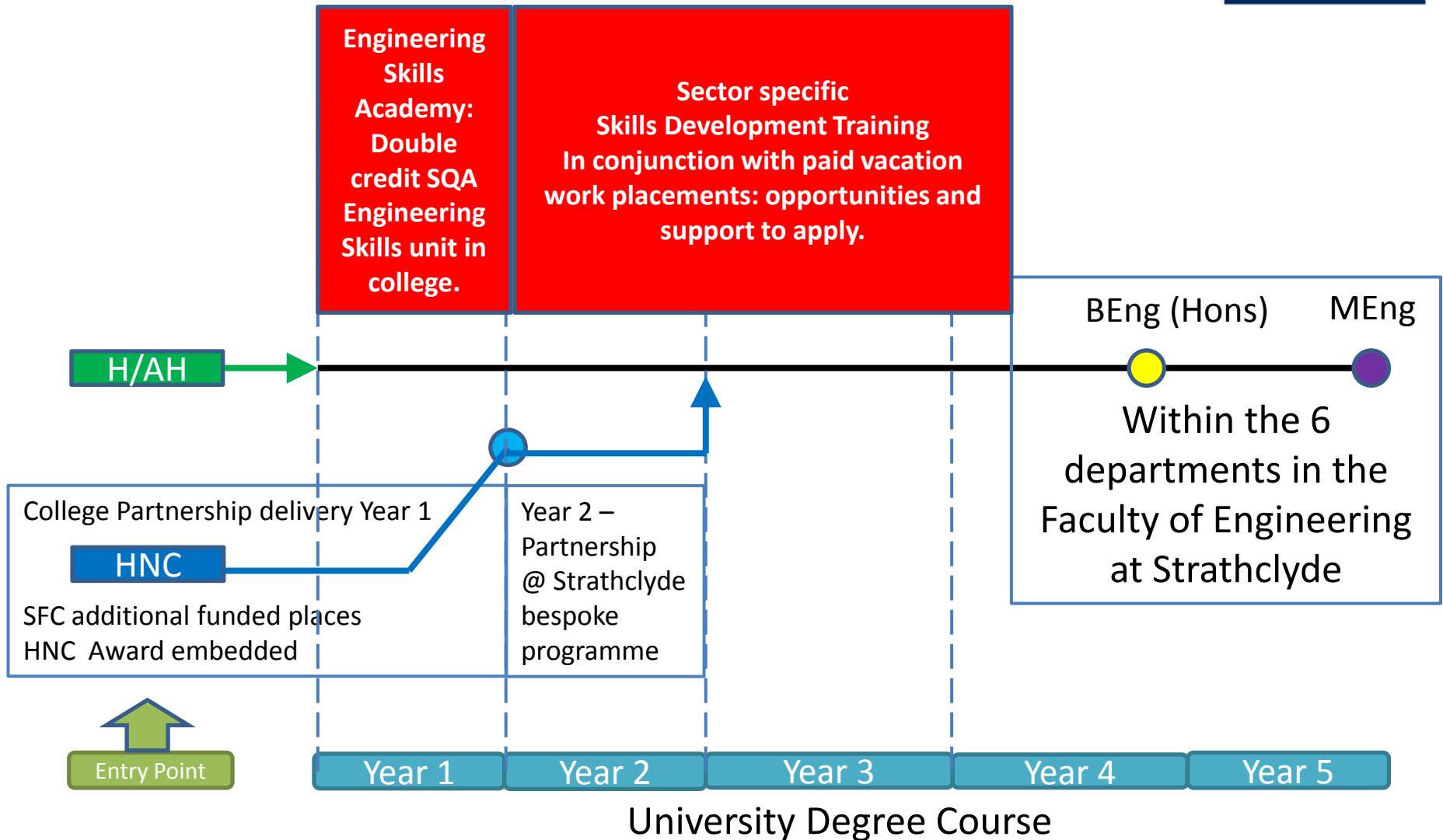
The Partnership

Progression to Strathclyde

- Progression to second year guaranteed subject to satisfactory completion of programme
 - Pass all units within enhanced HNC curriculum
 - A in graded unit
 - Completion of skills development training
- Second year students provided with additional support and induction
- Third year onwards is identical to regular curriculum

Engineering Academy

The Engineering Academy is a pioneering programme that offers you an alternative route into university and employment as a Strathclyde student. The first year is an enhanced HNC programme with direct transfer into second year of one of our engineering degrees.

The Academy is a collaboration between the University of Strathclyde, partner colleges and the engineering industry.

As part of the University's outreach objective, the Academy was established to increase widening access participation by delivering various pathways to a range of engineering degrees in our leading Faculty of Engineering.

Typical Entry Requirements

We typically look for 4 Highers at Grade B and these must include Maths and Physics or, for entry to Chemical Engineering, Maths, Chemistry and Physics, or for entry to Biomedical Engineering, Maths, Physics and Biology or Human Biology.



- Apply through UCAS: Code OBRT
 - Entry standards BBBB at Higher
 - Including Maths and Physics
 - Chemistry also required for Chemical Engineering
 - Match applicant to discipline and college
- Alternative: Access to Engineering course (in college)
