

Advanced Highers

 An Advanced Higher and a Higher are given equal credit and the grades for each qualification count towards the total grades required.

PLUS 2 Highers at B (including English)
PLUS Maths qualification



HNC Entry Qualifications

ABB plus two Highers at B (including English)



Pre-entry Access Course

 Pass mark of 60%, plus three Highers (including English at B), and relevant Maths requirements



Scottish Widening Access Programme (West)

- Scottish Wider Access Programme (Access to Humanities), which includes Intermediate 2 Maths, Communications 4 & Literature 1.
- No additional Highers/Maths qualifications required.
- SWAP West have a selection process for their candidates that is designed by SWAP but which academic staff at the University of Strathclyde are involved with.
- This comprises an internal application and interview at SWAP before a student can apply via UCAS. All SWAP West students being offered a place should receive this only in conjunction with Kenny Anderson at the Scottish Wider Access Programme.
- UCAS offer is ABB from SWAP programme.



Application Process

Personal statement and reference require evidence of ...

- a strong commitment to Education
- experience of working with children in a formal setting (preferred)
- interests beyond the classroom
- learning from experience



Selection Procedures

- 1100 applicants in 2016/ 1200 in 2015/ 1100 for 2014
- 152 places offered in 2015/16
- Total number of places fixed by government
- No interview for first year entry
- Selection procedure between Year 1 and 2

Being a first year at Strathclyde



- Education lectures are interactive

- Professional development opportunities are on offer




