

It was useful to see the tracking and progress capability with some suggestions being made by parents regarding adjustments that could perhaps improve the tracking report experience. It was useful to be shown how the database manages information such as attendance, behaviour, support for learning and much more and the impact this has for class teachers, pupil support and senior management within the school. It was clear from the Calderhead Cares presentation that there is a real benefit to pupils, teachers, senior management, and parents from using this system. 


95 pupils in S1

67 pupils represented at parents evening and given survey


55 responses - 82% return rate (usual response rate ~25-30%)
