
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Salsburgh. We intend to follow up with a working breakfast combined with an offer to tour the school. We plan to invite other employers in the local area.

Outward Bound has a good reputation in the school. Places have been secured by several young people from senior pupils. This upcoming trip has been targeted at girls in leadership. Future trips will be targeted at the boys' football team.

John shared his concerns about attendance. The concern for increasing absences was shared by the parent council. There are plans in place to improve attendance through one-to-one time with pupils/staff during House Time and through the campus Police Officer.

School Improvement Plan

John presented the School Improvement Plan and presented various aspects of it to the group. One of the main focuses of the plan is to improve attendance thus increasing attainment within the school.

Cllr Leckie asked a question regarding the role of Janitorial staff and whether the best use of their time is gardening for Dykehead PS. John explained that the role of janitorial staff has changed. They are now called Facilitators and have a much wider remit including gardening responsibilities for their assigned cluster schools.
