

Welcome Audra welcomed everyone to the meeting and introductions were made for the benefit of new parents. Minutes from last meeting, September 7 th , 2023, were approved (AM) and seconded (GM).			
Maths Journey at Calderhead Maxine Paterson (PT Maths) presented the journey of maths at Calderhead - from \$1 (BGE) maths right up to senior school. We heard about the decisions that are made in 3 rd and 4 th year relating to what level of course a pupil will attempt and the decisions that are made in respect of which course - Maths and / or Application of Maths. Maxine is attending further study at Strathclyde University to allow her to teach Higher Application of Maths. Maxine made the group aware that the Maths department have an open-door policy for pupils and outlined additional support in the form of after school classes, easter school and masterclasses.

Evelyn Abernethy, Art and Design has been absent since March. Originally, we were able to use a retired Art teacher. Since August Miss Townsley has been covering. We are continuing to follow the NLC Managing Attendance Policy to support Ms Abernethy back to work.

We have an ASNA vacancy, disappointingly I have not been given a timescale for an appointment process.

Validated Self Evaluation

This took place 19th to 21st September. The core team included Jacqueline Burton, Education and Families Manager, Christine Creaney, Headteacher Coatbridge High School, our Digital Lead and our CIIL. Staff appreciated Jacqueline speaking to them in advance. I also reminded staff of a list of positive attributes of Calderhead High School. Staff were observed at least twice, apart from two members of staff who were not observed at all. The VSE Lead provided me with very positive oral feedback. The focus groups, lesson observations and our Scoping Paper had all been positive. They team were very impressed with the calm atmosphere in the school and the behaviour of the pupils. The way the pupils conducted themselves in corridors and around the building made a big impression.



Attendance

Pupil absence continues to be a concern. This is a concern across the UK and beyond. The current mean absence per day at Calderhead is:
