

CANDIDATES APPLYING THROUGH UCAS

2024

- If you are intending to go to university, at the end of this academic session, you need to apply through UCAS.
- It is your responsibility to ensure you will have the required entry grades/specified subjects. This can be done by checking individual universities courses. You are responsible for researching!
- You will have the opportunity to sign up to the UCAS Hub during our workshops. This will help with a several areas including the online process and personal statements. This should be the first thing you do today!

- You have already been furnished with materials to help you produce a personal statement. Your deadline for this statement is Wednesday 29th November. You should ensure whoever is doing your reference sees first and second draughts as soon as possible. I will add assignments to the UCAS Team so there is no excuses for things not been handed in on time.
- You have also be issued with a "UCAS Pupil Info" sheet. This will help you with your personal statement. Make sure you fill it out in it's entirety, including as much information as possible with regards to extra-curricular and community involvement. This is an opportunity for you to sell yourself! Your referee no longer writes a traditional reference so the onus is on YOU!

- You will be issued with 5 "UCAS Reference Information" sheets. The first two lines of this form should be completed by you and ensure you fill in what you are planning to study. These should now be given to firstly- the subjects you are being presented for this year and if you have some left over give them to a teacher who taught you last year, only if necessary.
- Using the buzzword- Caldervale2024- you should then register with UCAS.
